From Pastor's desk: Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018.

Reflection: He taught them as one having authority.

In today's Gospel, we hear of Jesus's first miracle as told in Mark's Gospel, the story of Jesus driving an unclean spirit out of a man. Ancients believed that certain diseases were caused by unclean spirits inhabiting the person. Mark shapes the meaning of this story by giving it a rather lengthy introduction and conclusion. "What is this? A new teaching with authority?" The story prompts us to ask about the source of Jesus' authority both in speech and in action. Notice the irony, that the unclean spirit is the one who reveals Jesus' true identity! Why is that? We heard Jesus healing the sick and afflicted. He is just beginning his public ministry but as he drives out demons and heals lepers, his renown and his popularity increase quickly. Jesus drives out an unclean spirit. The people are astonished, not just at his actions, but also he taught with such authority.

Lord Jesus, cast out the destructive forces in our lives. By your word, we pray, awaken us, touch our hearts, and change our thinking. Fill us with the spirit of compassion and love.

Reflexión: Él les enseñó como alguien que tiene autoridad

En el Evangelio de hoy, nos enteramos del primer milagro de Jesús según lo narrado en el Evangelio de Marcos, la historia de Jesús expulsando a un hombre de un espíritu inmundo. Los antiguos creían que ciertas enfermedades eran causadas por suciedad introducción y conclusión. "¿Que es esto? ¿Una nueva enseñanza con autoridad? "La historia nos impulsa a preguntar acerca de la fuente de la autoridad de Jesús tanto en el habla como en la acción. Note la ironía de que el espíritu inmundo es el que revela la verdadera identidad de Jesús ¿Porqué es eso? Escuchamos a Jesús sanar a los enfermos y afligidos. Está comenzando su ministerio público, pero como expulsa a los demonios y sana a los leprosos, su renombre y su popularidad aumentan rápidamente. Jesús expulsa un espíritu inmundo. La gente está asombrada, no solo por sus acciones, sino que también enseñó con tanta autoridad introducción y conclusión. "

Señor Jesús, descarta las fuerzas destructivas en nuestras vidas. Por su palabra, oramos, nos despiertan, tocan nuestros corazones y cambian nuestro pensamiento. Llénanos con el espíritu de compasión y amor.
