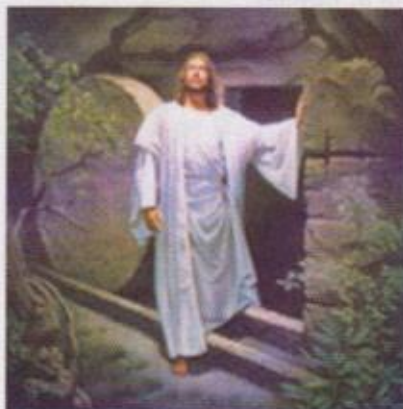

From Pastor's desk: Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord 2018.

Reflection: John 20, 1 - 9: He had to rise from the dead.

Today's Gospel is part of a longer post-Resurrection narrative, which ends with Mary Magdalene being commissioned to preach to Jesus' disciples saying, "I have seen the Lord!" As the scene opens, we learn that Mary Magdalene came to the garden tomb before dawn. It made her the first witness of the empty tomb. When Peter and the Beloved Disciple respond to her summons, both witness the signs of Jesus Death- the burial wrappings, but at this moment only one "saw and believed". Alleluia! The Tomb is empty! After weeks of drawing near to Christ's suffering and Death, we joyously celebrate his Resurrection! How blessed we are to belong to Jesus, who knows our pain, suffering, and sin yet offers us hope through his mercy, forgiveness, and love. Are you experiencing pain that separates you from the joy of this holy Day? You are not alone. Spend time in prayer, sharing your pain with God, with Jesus. Ask God for what you need. Know that Christ's heart joins with yours and all who are suffering. Jesus has redeemed us and has given us the hope of eternal life. Let our celebration today raise us up and renew our lives by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Cuando Pedro y el discípulo amado responden a su llamado, ambos atestiguan los signos de la muerte de Jesús: los envoltorios del entierro, pero en este momento solo uno "vio y creyó". ¡Aleluya! ¡La tumba está vacía! ¡Después de semanas de acercarnos al sufrimiento de Cristo y a la Muerte, celebramos gozosamente su Resurrección! Cuán bendecidos somos por pertenecer a Jesús, quien conoce nuestro dolor, sufrimiento y pecado, pero nos ofrece esperanza a través de su misericordia, perdón y amor. ¿Estás experimentando dolor que te separa de la alegría de este día santo? No estas solo. Pase tiempo orando, compartiendo su dolor con Dios, con Jesús. Pídele a Dios lo que necesitas. Sepa que el corazón de Cristo se une a los suyos y a todos los que sufren. Jesús nos ha redimido y nos ha dado la esperanza de la vida eterna. Deje que nuestra celebración hoy nos levante y renueve nuestras vidas por el poder del Espíritu Santo.
