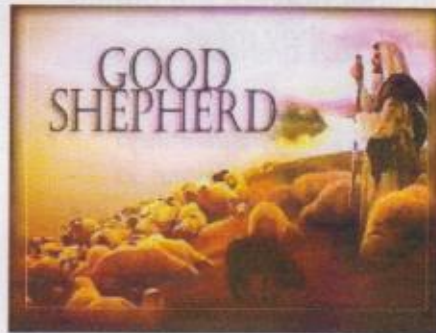

From Pastor's desk: Fourth Sunday of Easter 2018. Reflection: John 10, 11-18: The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. We continue our celebration of the Lord's Resurrection with some familiar images of him that can give us comfort. John writes that Jesus called himself the Good Shepherd, the one who lays down his life for his sheep. John uses the image of the Good Shepherd to explain what it means to be a faith community. It is about our shared trust in Christ who put his life on the line to take care of his flock and keep them secure. It is about a flock that can be open and welcoming to other without fear for its safety, because the one who laid down his life for them has taken it up again as the Father commanded. The powerful image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd expresses Christ's love and care for us, especially in his act of laying down his life for ours. Jesus emphasizes the importance of a mutual, charitable relationship with him. As Pope Francis notes in the encyclical, she is not afraid to get close to the sheep. He states, "Evangelizers thus take on the smell of the sheep and the sheep are willing to hear their voice" **Our God and Shepherd, you know me and the paths I take. May I seek you out in my joys and sorrows, always desiring to hear your voice. Give us eyes to see your Son in each person we encounter. May we care for others as you mercifully care for all of us.**

Desde el escritorio del Pastor: Cuarto domingo de Pascua 2018. Reflexión: Juan 10, 11 - 18: El buen pastor da su vida por las ovejas. Continuamos nuestra celebración de la Resurrección del Señor con algunas imágenes familiares de él que pueden darnos consuelo. Juan escribe que Jesús se llamó a sí mismo el Buen Pastor, el que da su vida por sus ovejas. John usa la imagen del Buen Pastor para explicar lo que significa ser una comunidad de fe. Se trata de nuestra confianza compartida en Cristo que arriesgó su vida para cuidar de su rebaño y mantenerlo seguro. Se trata de un rebaño que puede abrirse y acoger a los demás sin temor por su seguridad, porque el que dio su vida por ellos ha vuelto a tomarlo como el Padre le ordenó. La poderosa imagen de Jesús como el Buen Pastor expresa el amor de Cristo y nos cuida, especialmente en su acto de dar su vida por la nuestra. Jesús enfatiza la importancia de una relación mutua y caritativa con él. Como lo señala el Papa Francisco en la encíclica, ella no está miedo de acercarse a las ovejas. Él dice: "Los evangelizadores asumen el olor de las ovejas y las ovejas están dispuestas a escuchar su voz." **Nuestro Dios y Pastor, tú me conoces y los caminos que tomo. Que pueda buscarte en mis alegrías y tristezas, siempre deseando escuchar tu voz. Danos la oportunidad de ver a tu Hijo en cada persona con la que nos encontremos. Que nos preocupemos por los demás mientras usted misericordiosamente se preocupa por todos nos.**
